Communion

*What do you focus on when we celebrate Communion together? Jesus said to “Do this in remembrance of Me.” Most of us think of our salvation, purchased with His sacrifice in our behalf. That is so powerful! Is it actually more than that? The apostle Paul gave us some enlightening instructions about partaking of the Lord’s Supper in **I Corinthians 11:17-34**.*

*He was replying to the Corinthian believer’s request for help dealing with divisions occurring among them. He began by reminding them in **Ch.1:10-13** that Christ is not divided, and neither should those be who are His body, the church in their city, **Ch.1:2**. That remains true for those of us who are His church in our city too.*

*Addressing what had become their divisive individuality he said, “Whoever eats the bread or drinks the cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of sinning against the body and blood of the Lord.” (**Ch.11:27**) He also said, “For those who eat and drink **without discerning the body of Christ** eat and drink judgment on themselves.” (**Ch.11:29**)*

WOW! REALLY? Really. What does that mean? What is he writing to them about? He is writing to them, and us about the dangers of seeing our own salvation as being the most important thing to celebrate. He is writing about losing sight of the far more important identity of being saved into His body, not as a single, individual part. He is writing about our far more important role as a functioning, interdependent member of His body with all of the other members He has joined together to represent Him fully, as we can only do together.

*He goes on to present in God authored detail, especially in **Ch. 12:12-27**, how it is we are unable to adequately represent who Christ is where we live without the rest of His body, the church. When participating in the Lord’s Supper we are in reality identifying our absolute need for each other.*

*The apostle John goes so far as to say in **I John 4:17**, “Love has been perfected **among us** in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because **as He is, so are we in this world**.” The we in “so are we” is plural. No sane person can suppose to be the fullness of who Christ is on their own. **Ephesians 4:11-16** makes it abundantly clear as well.*

So, let’s remember Christ Jesus when we partake of the Lord’s Supper, embracing His sacrifice for the redemption of all who would believe on Him, committed to representing Him well together where we live in the Communion of the saints.
