### Being Influential

You are influential. I'm not talking about the Internet phenomenon of being an "Influencer." Our culture's infatuation with celebrity is so sad. What's the message? That everyone else is of no consequence in the lives of other people? Those "influencers" who supposedly impact the lifestyles of millions may have fewer personal friends who influence each other by how they live and interact than you and I do.

For good or not good, you and I are influential. How we live has an impact in the lives of those we live among. Even if we've never given it a thought, it's what happens. We can't avoid it. Jesus said it's one of the primary ways His kingdom operates. He said in **Matthew 13:33**, "The kingdom of heaven is like leaven (yeast), which a woman took and hid in three measures of meal till it was all leavened." You and I are that yeast He has tucked into the community we live in.

The question is, if we're not being influential in His behalf, what influence are we having? Because He also said in **Matthew 12:30**, "He who is not with Me is against Me, and he who does not gather with Me scatters." There is no neutral ground. The bigger question is, who and what do we allow to influence us?

The culture around us that does not live to honor Christ Jesus is pouring forth a tidal wave of pessimism, cynicism, criticism, doubt, worry and fear. That seed grows a crop of misery and despair. God, on the other hand offers us "love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control," **Galatians 5:22-23**. We not only get to choose what influences we embrace or indulge, but we must. The fruit of God's Spirit does not grow by default. We receive His good seed and cultivate what He offers us on purpose. Gardens that are not planted with good seed, and cultivated grow weeds. And weeds spread more weeds. Influence.

If you went to a community market and vendors were offering both crops, which would you choose? Not only how you will be treated, but what you will make available to the people you encounter. And the more good we give to other people, God replenishes and increases our provision so we are always overflowing with the good things of life and love He designed and redeemed us for.

II Corinthians 9:10-11, "Now the One who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed and increase the harvest of your righteousness. You will be enriched in every way for all generosity, which produces thanksgiving to God through us." Together as His people, the church, we become like one of those fresh fruit stands outside of Yakima on Hwy 410, stocked with all of the fresh fruit grown in the farms of the valley there.

You are influential. How? The choice is yours. Choose wisely. It will make a greater difference than you will know this side of heaven.

The Genesis Project is a Seattle-based registered 501(c)3 non-profit organization that exists to offer hope for a new life to young women and girls involved in commercial sexual exploitation (CSE), prostitution, and sex trafficking. The mission of the Genesis Project is to provide needed services to survivors of CSE and sex trafficking in a three phase approach including immediate shelter, education, job skills training, and long-term safe houses. Ultimately, this love, support, and care will draw women toward a future of hope.

Our Drop-in Day Center is dedicated to serving female survivors of prostitution and sex trafficking. We do this with a small team of dedicated case managers and with the help of volunteers, law enforcement officers, state legislators, churches, community groups, FBI task forces, and international partner organizations.
