A. No. But a tetanus shot would be good to have.

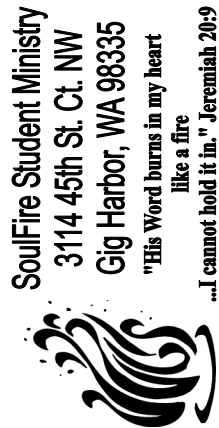
Q. How much spending money do I need?

I am excited that you are prayerfully considering this year's missions trip. We are traveling to Tepic, Mexico to minister with Pastor Dwight Hansen and his wonderful staff and congregation at La Fuente Ministries. Pastor Dwight is from the Northwest and is one of PCF's financially supported missionaries. He has spoken at PCF and SoulFire numerous times. Tepic is a city of about 500,000 that is located in the mountains about 100 miles inland (Northeast) from Puerto Vallarta. Tepic is the capital city on Nayarit. Nayarit is one of the poorest states or provinces in Mexico, it also has a 2% Christian Population. For more information on La Fuente ministries see www.lafuentemin.com.

The tentative dates of our outreach are **July 26—August 5**. This brochure should have most of the basic trip information on it. However, I want to remind you and encourage you that if you have any questions to please ask me as soon as you can.

PARENTS:

PAYMENT SCHEDULE:
