Some people claiming His name are publicly separating over worldly opinions

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- Both claiming to represent Him in their disagreement
- Does that happen in heaven?
- Is it His answer to our prayer?

If we stand together in **who Christ is**...

- Don't separate from each other over nonessentials
- He doesn't stand in either camp (Abraham Lincoln)
- He stands on His own

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Joshua 5:13-14, And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?"

So **He** said, "**No**, but as **Commander** of the army of the Lord I have now come."

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Those contending with each other over **who He** stands with...

- Are **both** misrepresenting Him

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I Corinthians 1:10-13, "Is Christ divided?"

That being said, let's take a look at what He said about the kingdom we're asking for...

- In light of today's culture of worldly wisdom.

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Matthew 20:1-16, "For the kingdom of heaven is **like** a landowner who went out early in the morning to hire **laborers for his vineyard**. Now when he had agreed with the laborers for a denarius a day, he sent them into his vineyard. And he went out about the third hour and saw others standing idle in the marketplace, and said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right I will give you.' So they went. Again he went out about the sixth and the ninth hour, and did likewise. And about the eleventh hour he went out and found others standing idle, and said to them, 'Why have you been standing here idle all day?' They said to him, 'Because no one hired us.' He said to them, 'You also go into the vineyard, and whatever is right you will receive.'

"So when evening had come, the owner of the vineyard said to his steward, 'Call the laborers and give them their wages, beginning with the last to the first.' And when those came who were hired about the eleventh hour, they each received a denarius. But when the first came, they supposed that they would receive more; and they likewise received each a denarius. And when they had received it, they complained **against the landowner**, saying, 'These last men have worked only one hour, and you made them equal **to us** who have borne the burden and the heat of the day.' But he answered one of them and said, 'Friend, I am doing you no wrong. **Did you not** agree with me for a denarius? Take what is yours and go your way. I wish to give to this last man the same as to you. Is it not lawful for me to do what I wish with my own things? Or is your eye evil
