What keeps us from embracing this with confidence?

- Considering it through the lens of who we are...
- Instead of the lens of Who He IS!

Genesis 3 (Before & after Easter)

.....

- When they sinned, they became selfcentered, instead of God-centered
- They realized they were naked, and were afraid
- They saw God through their eyes, instead of...
- Seeing themselves through God's eyes
- God made coverings from animal skins (death) for them

"Witnesses" = Martyr, Having died in His name

- **Romans 6:8**, Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him
- I Cor. 15:31, by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.

Is being His witnesses more about **Him in us**, or **us in Him**?

John 15:1-6 (Vs. 6), If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and

they gather them and throw them into the fire, and they are burned.

He is complete & perfect! We are partial.

Ephesians 1 & 2

- 1:1, Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints who are in Ephesus, and faithful in Christ Jesus
- 1:3, Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places **in Christ**
- 1:4, just as He chose us <u>in Him</u> before the foundation of the world
- 1:6, by which He made us accepted <u>in the</u> **Beloved**.
- 1:7, <u>In Him</u> we have redemption through His
- 1:9, according to His good pleasure which He purposed **in Himself**
- 1:10, He might gather together in one all things <u>in Christ</u>, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.
- 1:11, <u>In Him</u> also we have obtained an inheritance
- 1:12, that we who first trusted <u>in Christ</u> should be to the praise of His glory
- 1:13, <u>In Him</u> you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth
- 2:6, and made us sit together in the heavenly places **in Christ Jesus**
- 2:7, the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us **in Christ Jesus**

- 2:10, For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works
- 2:13, in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ
- 2:15, so as to create <u>in Himself</u> one new man from the two
- 2:21, <u>in whom</u> the whole building, being fitted together

In Ephesians, "In Christ" or the equivalent appears 35 times

"In Christ" – when we are consumed in who He is...

- Disappearing into Him

.....

I Corinthians 12:12-27

- Eyes, ears, hands, nose, feet & organs...
- Is the body alive in the parts?
- Or, are the parts alive **in the body**?
- Whose body?

Christ Jesus died – to cover us **in His Body**

.....

Romans 6:8, Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him

I Corinthians 15:31, I affirm, by the boasting in you which I have in Christ Jesus our Lord, I die daily.

.....

Romans 13:14, But **put on the Lord Jesus Christ**, and make no provision for the flesh

Galatians 3:27, For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have **put on Christ**.

- "Put on" = To "clothe", to "sink into a garment", to "rest in"
- To "give self wholly to"

Colossians 3:9 says we must first "Put off the old man with his deeds"

How?

I John 1:9, If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Psalm 51:1-4,

Have mercy upon me, O God,
According to Your lovingkindness;
According to the multitude of Your tender mercies,
Blot out my transgressions.
Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity,
And cleanse me from my sin.
For I acknowledge my transgressions,
And my sin is always before me.
Against You, You only, have I sinned,
And done this evil in Your sight—
That You may be found just when You speak,
And blameless when You judge.
