- 1. Don't use what God's given you to laden someone else. Share the load (Matt 11:28-29)
- 2. Don't put your dynasty in front of God's kingdom
- 3. Pray that God directs your steps (Prov 16:9)

- A. The people are scattered, but he uses us to help (Matt10:1)
- 1. Sampson's end: (Judges 14:4, 16:28-30)
- 2. Elijah's end: (I Kings 19:11-17)
